

2019 John XXIII College Year 7 Family Purchased Student Device

John XXIII College is a BYODD (bring your own designated device) school from Years 4 to 12.

To cater for the different needs of families from Years 7 to 12, the College has formed a partnership with Winthrop Australia to offer several laptop options. Families can choose to select a device bundle that meets their requirements from a range of available pricing options.

The table below outlines the computer device minimum requirements for Year 7 students in 2019:

Minimum requirements

Windows 10 Laptop



- Operating system Windows 10
- 13-inch **Touch Screen with** Digital pen capabilities (12-inch acceptable)
- Processor Intel Core i5
- Memory: 8 GB RAM
- Storage: 256GB SSD/FLASH (128GB acceptable)
- USB 3.0 Ports or Adaptor from USB-C to USB 3.0
- HDMI or DV Port / Adaptor
- Webcam "Self-facing camera" (front facing camera is optional)
- Bluetooth
- Wi-Fi 802.11ac support for 5GHz
- Virus scanner Windows Defender
- Protective case (a protective hard-case can be added to some devices. This may suit your child)
- Laptop sleeve (optional) or carry bag (optional). Highly recommended if a hard-case is not available for your device of choice.

There are three options for families purchasing the student device bundle:

- 1. Purchase the device bundle from our business partner Winthrop Australia at: https://sales.winaust.com.au/shop/john23 (recommended).
- Purchase the device and additions from the Catholic Education Portal for parents at: https://www.jbeducation.com.au/byod/ (note: School Code is CEWA2019). Please choose a device bundle that meets the minimum requirements in the table above.
- 3. Families have the option of sourcing the device and additions from a vendor of choice. Please choose a device that meets the minimum requirements in the table above.



Note: The College has negotiated a 'drop/off pick-up' service for laptops <u>purchased from Winthrop Australia</u> that may need repair or replacement. This service will operate through the College ICT Help Desk.
