

# FEES AND CHARGES 2024

## Application Fee

In order to register a student for enrolment, an Application for Enrolment form must be completed with an administration fee of \$120 (inc GST). This fee is non-refundable and does not guarantee enrolment.

## Acceptance of Enrolment Fee

This fee is payable on acceptance of an offer of enrolment for all children. This fee is non-refundable and is as follows:
