They fully embraced the opportunities that Year 12 presented.



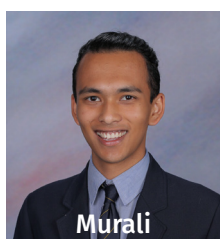
College Dux, Murali

ATAR of 99+ (Top 1% in the State)



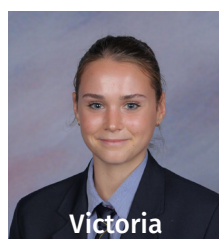
